AWARD CRITERIA

1. The student must be enrolled full-time at UW-Platteville in the semester preceding the international experience.
2. Students enrolled as 'special students' are not eligible.
3. The maximum that a student can receive during a year in support of international study shall be \$1800 for a Wisconsin resident student with financial need and \$725 for a student without financial need. A student cannot receive an award for two consecutive semesters of study in the same program.
4. No monetary award will be made unless the form has been duly signed by the study abroad director, college coordinator, **or** short-term course instructor/s.

Specific Criteria for \$1800 International Study Grant:

- a. The student must be **an undergraduate and a Wisconsin resident** who is registered at UWP as a full-time student in an approved semester long study abroad or one-to-one international exchange program.
- b. The student must have a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) on file in the UWP Financial Aid Office and must demonstrate financial need, as determined by the FAO (using the Federal Needs Analysis).

Specific Criteria for \$725 International Study Scholarship:

- a. The student must be **a U.S. citizen or a permanent resident alien** who is registered at UWP as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student in an approved semester long study abroad or one-to-one international exchange program.
- b. The student does not have to demonstrate financial need.

Specific Criteria for \$300 "short term international study" grant:

- a. The student must be **a U.S. citizen or permanent resident alien** who is registered at UWP for at least 3 academic credits in an approved UWP international study program.
- b. The student must have a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) on file in the UWP Financial Aid Office and must demonstrate financial need, as determined by the FAO (using the Federal Needs Analysis).

Special note: The student will be responsible for repayment of any awarded international study scholarships and grants if he/she does not complete the program requirements or drops below full-time status (12 credits for semester, 6 credits for summer and 3 credits for short-term, faculty-led programs).
